

<p>Literacy: We will be looking at recording and making marks with meaning in Nursery, for example making treasure maps and messages in bottles. In Reception we will be beginning to write our own pirate stories.</p> <p>Key Texts: Pirates Love Underpants, The Pirates are Coming! Jolley-Rogers and the Monster's Gold, The Treasure of Pirate Frank, Pirate Pete and his Stinky Feet.</p>	<p>Reception Maths: We will be focusing on numbers to 20 this term to really understand about number facts, addition and subtraction.</p> <p>Nursery Maths: We will be doing lots of practical counting, ordering and sorting with number to 5, and learning order and names for number to 10.</p> <p>All: Exploring pattern and comparing size, weight and capacity.</p>	<p>Reception Phonics: We will be continuing our phonics sessions daily working in small groups differentiated by either Phase 3, 4 or 5 as appropriate.</p> <p>Nursery Phonics: We will be continuing to identify sounds orally and develop our understanding of different sounds, language pattern and rhyme.</p>
