

<p><u>English</u></p> <p>We will continue to have our daily phonics sessions.</p> <p>In English we will be learning to write for a purpose. We will be thinking about our sentence structure to write, lists, letters, stories and poetry.</p> <p>Our Key texts this term will be <i>Home</i> by Carson Ellis and the <i>The House That Was Once</i> by Julie Fogliano & Lane Smith.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>This term, we will be continuing to learn all about number and place value, securing what we know and extending our understanding of how numbers work. We will look at the part-whole method (ask us if you are not sure!) before linking this to addition and subtraction calculations within numbers to 20. We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shapes.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>This term we will continue our learning about materials. We will distinguish between objects and the material from which they are made, beginning to describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials. We will observe and describing weather associated with changed of season and how the day length varies.</p>
<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>We will explore the world of digital art and it's exciting range of creative tools, creaingne our own digital paintings taking inspiration from a range of artists. Reading at home is essential to your child's reading development and fluency. It does not have to be the whole book – even two or three pages! Afterwards ask questions about what they have just read.
