

<p><b><u>English</u></b></p> <p>This term, we will link our writing to our History topic 'Ancient Greeks'. We will be focusing on the books 'Theseus and the Minotaur' and various non-fiction books about Ancient Greece.</p> <p>We will be focusing on the book; 'Who Let The Gods Out?' as our class read.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>This term, Macaws will be learning about time, area and perimeter.</p> <p>This term, Jaguars will be building on their previous knowledge of decimals and percentages. We will be using the four operations to add, subtract, multiply and divide decimals.</p>	<p><b><u>Geography/ History</u></b></p> <p>This term, we will be learning about Ancient Greece, its culture, mythology, and their influence on the western world. In Geography, we will be building on our prior knowledge and extending into further learning about Europe and its major cities.</p>
<p><b><u>Computing</u></b></p> <p>We will be link computing with our previous science topic of Forces and Resistance by continuing learning how to use data loggers by interrupting and analysing data.</p> <p><b><u>Art/DT</u></b></p> <p>We will be revisiting Art and DT in Term 6, following and building on our History topic of Ancient Greece. Art will focus on drawing and sketching of Greek pots and the stories they tell, and Textiles – creating pouches.</p>	<p><b>Respect and Courage</b></p> <p><b>Y 4 / 5 – Macaws</b></p> <p><b>Y5 - Jaguars</b></p> <p><b>Summer T5 2021-22</b></p>	<p><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>We will learn how to develop our throwing and catching skills in rounders, using batting techniques.</p> <p>We will also be returning to our swimming lessons during Term 5.</p> <p><b><u>Music</u></b></p> <p>This term, Macaws will be developing rhythm, listening and playing together skills through drumming with the Lincolnshire Music Service.</p> <p>Jaguars will listen to a range of music from different cultures, including those from Greece and across Europe. We will learn some simple songs.</p>
<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>This term, we will be learning about Sound. We will learn about how sound travels, how our ears recognise sound and the workings of the inner ear. We will be looking at different sounds we can hear and how loud they are.</p>	<p><b><u>Home Learning</u></b></p> <p>Children are expected to read 10 pages, 5 times a week. This can be either their Accelerated Reader book or their Stage book. Children will complete quizzes on these in school. For each 25, 50, 75 and 100 reads your child will receive a bookmark. For 150 reads your child will receive a book of their choice.</p> <p>Spellings practise for a timed activity every Friday.</p> <p>Times table rockstars to be completed as often as they can. Children can progress through the home reward scheme and earn prizes.</p>	<p><b><u>RE</u></b></p> <p>During RE, we will be learning about Islam and following a path through life, as well as developing our understanding of how religious values inform life choices and patterns.</p> <p><b><u>PHSE</u></b></p> <p>We will be learning about smoking. We will be learning about the risks associated with smoking and the addictive ingredients within cigarettes and other smoking products. We will also look at how smoking can affect your immediate and future health and wellbeing.</p>
