

<p><b><u>English</u></b></p> <p>We will continue to have our daily phonics sessions. In English we will be learning about the endangered animal our class is named after: Kingfishers.</p> <p>We will also be busy writing labels and captions before building up to write sentences.</p> <p>Our key texts this term are: 'Grandad's Island' by <i>Benji Davies</i> and 'Pinocchio' by <i>Carlo Collodi</i>.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>This term, we will be consolidating our learning of numbers to 10. We will count and sort objects, count and write numbers, count backwards, identify one more and one less, compare numbers and learn to use a number line. We will then move on to learning about the part-whole method where we will begin to write number sentences and make and compare number bonds.</p>	<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>This term we will be learning all about materials. We will be learning to identify and name a variety of everyday materials including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock. We will distinguish between objects and the material from which they are made. We will begin to describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.</p>
<p><b><u>Computing</u></b></p> <p>We will be learning how to group data based upon its specific information. We shall achieve this through grouping and describing similar objects, labelling and matching these objects based upon their properties and making comparisons.</p> <p><b><u>Art/DT</u></b></p> <p>Art will be our focus this term. We will be exploring mark making and line, working with different materials through observational and collaborative pieces.</p>	<p><b>Respect</b></p> <p><b>Friendship and Love</b></p> <p><b>Y1</b></p> <p><b>Autumn 2022</b></p>	<p><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>We will be mastering basic movements such as running, jumping, throwing, catching and balance through multi-skills and learning to participate in team games through basketball.</p> <p><b><u>Music</u></b></p> <p>We will be looking at different types of music families play in their homes. We will then use our voices expressively and creatively, singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.</p>
<p><b><u>Geography</u></b></p> <p>This term we will be learning about weather and seasons, identifying the types of clothing to be worn within the different months.</p> <p><b><u>History</u></b></p> <p>This term we will be learning about Toys found in the home comparing the similarities and differences to toys from the past and present looking at how they have changed through time.</p>	<p><b><u>Home Learning</u></b></p> <p>Reading, reading and more reading. Reading at home is essential to your child's reading development and fluency.</p> <p>A <b>reading for pleasure book</b> will be sent home daily. A <b>phonics decodable book</b> will be sent home on a Friday to be returned on Mondays. Please ensure you sign the children's reading diary each time they read.</p>	<p><b><u>RE</u></b></p> <p>We will be looking at the idea of "Being Human" through Islam. We will be introduced to a Muslim world and learn about the 5 Pillars, Shahadah and Akhlaq.</p> <p><b><u>PHSE</u></b></p> <p>We will be ensuring the children have a smooth transition into Year 1, incorporating lots of elements of the EYFS curriculum. We will be looking at the importance of washing hands and water safety.</p>
