EYFS – Summer 2023

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In Reception our teachers are beginning to support us with our readiness for Year 1 which is exciting! We will experience transition days up to Year 1 in our new classes and meeting our new Teachers! We will start to have challenges out in our Provision which our teachers will set for us based on our next steps. We will be supported in building up resilience and perseverance to take on these challenges and complete them. We will also be attending morning whole school assemblies too!

Writing and Mark Making

In Reception, children will continue to develop their handwriting, partake in daily phonics spelling tests. We have opportunities to write about our 'News' along with now writing Pop stories to build up our stamina for writing! We are now Authors and create our own stories with Pop based around our interests! On a Friday, we write anything we want too, this is to challenge our imagination and independence when writing! In our free flow time outside, we have opportunities to mark make in our play too using clipboards!

Number and Numerical Patterns

In Reception we will be comparing quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognising when one quantity is greater than, less than or the same as the other quantity.

We will also use Number Blocks as a resource to enhance our maths learning. Within each classroom, we have a 'maths area' for the children to explore independently within their provision time which will always link to their current learning. We add weekly enhancements linked to our learning that week to our maths area for our children to access independently.

Things to look forward to!

We have our end of year trip to The Deep in Hull! We look forward to experiencing this opportunity and visiting a location out of our local area. Sports Day is something for us to join in with too and we are excited to have our families cheer us on! Our teachers will arrange for an ice cream van to visit us at school along with a Graduation Day to celebrate our achievements since being in Reception.

Physical Development

In Reception, we are now outside for PE. We are practicing our ball skills this half term with some sports day practice too! We will be using a range of different obstacle courses to challenge our physical abilities as well as being able to follow rules and achieve targets!

Reading

In Reception, children will enjoy new stories such as 'What the ladybird heard at the sea side', 'Winnie at the seaside' and 'Pirates love underpants!'. We have a Super 6 selection of stories which children can select from. We will continue to send home Phonics books with reading records weekly. All children partake in daily guided reading sessions where they have opportunities to develop their word reading, prosody and comprehension with their class teacher and their Little Wandle reading book.

In phonics we will continue into Phase 4 with our Little Wandle Reading Scheme. We are reading longer CVCC and CCVC words along with looking at our root words and different suffixes e.g. ed, ing, est and er and how these change the root words.

Understanding the World

In Reception, we will focus on different career aspirations and what these look like; hoping to broaden our horizons. We will look at what different jobs/careers people we know in our families may have had in the past too! Linked to our learning around flowers and plants along with the human body, we will explore different non fiction books which will be accessible in our free flow sessions.

Expressive Art and Design

In Reception our dress up and role play will involve more open ended resources and materials for our children to design and make their own outfits and costumes. We have a newly built stage in our outside area with added microphones for us to perform shows!
