

## English

This term we will be continuing our English on WW2. We will be continuing to read “Letters from the Lighthouse” by Emma Carroll. The children will be using inspiration and ideas from these texts to write persuasive letters, discussion texts as well as continuing to develop our skills through different forms of narrative. We will revisit the grammar from year 5 and continue to apply our learning of active and passive voice and semi-colons and colons.

## Computing

We will learn about 3-D modelling this term. This unit will look at how to resize, duplicate and manipulate objects within a 3-D environment and look at creating 3-D objects by laying basic shapes.

## DT

This term we will be looking at linking our DT with our science. We will be using our knowledge about electricity and circuits to make a steady hand game.

## Science

We will be revisiting learning about electricity from Y4 and building on that knowledge. We will be learning about components and what symbols are used in circuit diagrams. We will look at how circuit diagrams are drawn and think about how components can be affected by changes in the circuit.

## PSHE

We will be continuing to look at in-app purchases and how finances and budgeting works with a focus on how to save money by making choices about what to buy.

## Maths

In Maths this term we will be developing skills learnt in year 5 including:

- Fractions – comparing, ordering, fractions of number
- Fractions – adding and subtracting fractions and problems involving fractions. Multiplying and dividing fractions
- Converting measure including looking at imperial measures

## Geography

This term we will be looking at the UK. We will look at the answers to some of these questions:

- What are the similarities and differences between the different countries of the UK?
- How have people affected the UK's landscape?
- What industries do the people in the UK work in?

## RE

This term we will be looking rites of passage in the Christian faith including marriage. Towards the end of the term, we will look at the Christmas story.

## Music

This term we will be looking a singing including singing in harmony, singing with echoes, and singing with an audience in mind.

## PE

With JB Sports this term we will be developing our football skills, thinking about the skills we need to develop as well as learning about different tactics and strategies to play the game successfully. We will also be taking part in OAA, looking at participating in a team, looking at different roles and how to adapt to different situations.

## MfL - Spanish

In Spanish this term we will be learning to say birthday related phrases, as well as learning the language around days, dates, and celebrations.

## Home Learning

Reading, reading and more reading. Reading at home is essential to your child's reading development and fluency. It does not have to be the whole book – in year 6 the children are expected to read a minimum of 10 pages every day which will need recording in their reading records.

Additional homework may be given to individuals or whole class depending on areas that need to be revisited or reinforced. The children will have the tasks carefully explained when necessary.
