English

We will read The Watertower by Gary Crew and The Boy in the Tower by Polly Ho-Yen.

We will be writing the following text types:

Narrative: First person narrative and Third person narrative

Non-Fiction: Non-chronological report

We will continue to develop our knowledge of grammar learnt in Y6 as well as revisiting grammar from previous years.

Computing

We will learn to organise data into columns and rows to create our own data set. We will learn the importance of formatting data to support calculations, while also being introduced to formulas and begin to understand how they can be used to produce calculated data. Finally, we will create charts, and evaluate our results.

<u>Art</u>

This term we will be looking at 3-D art and sculpture and studying how artists use experiences to help formulate their ideas and plan their art.

Science

In our Evolution topic this term, we will learn the following:

- Living things change over time and fossils provide information about living things that inhabited Earth years ago
- Living things produce offspring of the same kind, but vary
- Animals and plants adapt to their environment.

Spanish

In Spanish, we will be learning our shapes and prepositions before applying this knowledge to describe and making pictures. We are also hoping to be able to use nouns to describe people's faces.

Maths

In maths this term we will be looking at some new concepts and revisiting and building on previous learning including:

- Understanding percentages and calculating percentage of amounts.
- Introducing ratio and proportion and solving questions related to them
- Introducing algebra and looking at finding rules, substitution, and formulae

Geography

In Geography this term, we will be focusing on Europe and its countries, specifically Greece. We will learn the location of Europe and the countries within and discuss why people would want to visit Mediterranean countries such as Greece. We will also look at the landscape within Greece and the main features of its capital, Athens.

<u>RE</u>

We will be looking at the question "Do you have to believe in God to be Good?" We will look at what good is and then look at Buddhism and Humanism to look at their beliefs.

<u>Music</u>

This term we will be looking at a Street Dance performance, looking at chordal accompaniments and following and interpreting complex graphic score for four instruments. We will also learn to sing and play ostinati from an early 20th century piece of work.

<u>PE</u>

We will develop our passing, receiving, and shooting skills through Netball.

We will develop our core stability and balance in Yoga. Please remember to come in correct PE kit to school, No earrings on **Tuesday** and **Wednesday**

<u>PSHE</u>

This term we will be looking at conception, building on the puberty unit from last year. We will study the reproductive system for male and female and look at how conception takes place as well as how a baby grows.
