English

In English, we will be basing our writing on our class novel, 'Holes'. We will be writing a selection of the narrative from the perspective of a different character. We will also be a persuasive text on a topic to be decided by the children.

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on multiplication and division alongside prime numbers, square numbers and cube numbers. We will then move onto fractions. We will be focusing on equivalent fractions and converting between mixed and improper fractions. We will then move onto adding and subtracting fractions, which will require converting to either mixed or improper fractions.

History

In history, we will be discovering the history of the railway in Lincolnshire and its impact on Skegness. We will be investigating the transport links prior to the railway arriving in Skegness.

Computing

We will be investigating different drawing tools. We will be investigating vectors (drawings using shapes). We will be investigating the effect of layering of shapes to create different pictures.

Art/DT

In art, we will be exploring painting and mixed media portraits. We will be investigating a combination of materials for effect, which we hope will be developing ideas towards an outcome by experimenting with materials and techniques.
