English

We will continue to have our daily phonics sessions focusing on the phase 5 phonemes.

We will be continuing our Guided reading sessions, focusing on decoding, prosody and comprehension skills.

In our English sessions we will be starting the term of by looking at poetry - 'Firework Night' by Andrew Collett. We will then move on to looking at the construction of a sentence where we will write in the style of a report based around the non-fiction book 'Toys from the past'.

Computing

We will be learning about computing systems and networks all around us. We will become familiar with different components of the computer by developing our keyboard and mouse skills.

DT will be our focus this term. We will plan, design and make puppets. We will learn different methods of joining fabrics together.

Science

Linking with our Geography learning we will be developing our understanding of seasonal change observing and describing the different weather and how the day length varies.

PSHE

We will be looking at water spillage and the importance of helping each other to prevent any unnecessary accidents. We will also be looking at bullying, recognising how our actions and words can affect others enabling us to explore kind and positive behaviours.

We will continue with our daily power maths sessions focusing on using our knowledge of place value to secure an understanding of addition and subtraction to 10. We will then move to shapes focusing on 2D and 3D shapes.

We will continue to have daily Maths Mastery sessions focusing on our subitising skills. We will gain a deeper understanding of number through using lots of practical equipment.
