English

In English, we will be linking our writing to Beowulf. We will be writing a legend based on the story. We will then be completing a non-chronological report based on the historical time period setting of Beowulf. We then hope to be able to investigate the poem 'The Highway Man'.

Maths

In maths, we will be revisiting fractions. Firstly, we will revisit fractions of amount before moving onto converting between fractions, decimals and percentages. We will be revisiting rounding through decimals giving answers to one and two decimal places. Then, we will move onto area and perimeter of squares, rectangles and rectilinear shapes.

History

In history, we will be learning about Anglo-Saxons, Vikings and Scots. We will be investigating where they came from and why they invaded and settled in Britain. We will be investigating how well they got on with each other along with what life was like during this period. We will be investigating King Alfred and what the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons left behind.

Computing

In computing, we will be focusing on databases. We will be learning how databases can be used. We will be making comparisons between paper and electronic databases.

Art

In Art this term, we will be focusing on developing structures and 3D installations. We will be planning and developing our ideas through a variety of resources. Please save your pop bottles and cardboard boxes.

In R.E., we will be revisiting the question: 'Do you have to believe in God to be good?' We will be investigating different ways that we can show we are being good. We will be investigating different religions and how they show they are being good.

Music

Science

In science, we will be learning about 'Living Things and their Habitats'. We will be learning about life cycles of animals. We will be investigating sexual and asexual plants and will be trying to make new plants.
