

English

This term, we will be continuing to read "Shrapnel Boys" by Jenny Pearson.

The children will be using inspiration and ideas from this text and a video called 'Beyond the Lines' to write a persuasive letter, a discussion text and a third person narrative. We will continue to develop our grammatical knowledge including relative clauses, parenthesis and, for Year 6, colons and semi-colons.

Computing

We will learn about 3-D modelling this term. This unit will look at how to resize, duplicate and manipulate objects within a 3-D environment and look at creating 3-D objects by laying basic shapes.

DT

This term we will be looking at linking our DT with our science. We will be using our knowledge about electricity and circuits to make a steady hand game.

Science

We will be revisiting learning about electricity from Y4 and building on that knowledge. We will be learning about components and what symbols are used in circuit diagrams. We will look at how circuit diagrams are drawn and think about how components can be affected by changes in the circuit.

PSHE

We will be finishing off our work on in-app purchases and how finances and budgeting works with a focus on how to save money by making choices about what to buy. We will then start to look Stealing and the idea of consent.

Geography

This term we will be looking at the UK. We will look at the answers to some of these questions:

- What are the similarities and differences between the different countries of the UK?
- How have people affected the UK's landscape?
- What industries do the people in the UK work in?

RE

This term we will deep diving into the how other religion worship. We will be identifying and investigating how Muslims and Jews worship, where they worship and what they worship. Discussing key values of the different religions and how it impacts their lives.

Music

This term we will be looking at a Latin song called 'Dona nobis pacem'. Throughout the learning we will be exploring pulse work and compare music with different textures. They will create their own pieces using rhythms and cords.

PE

In P.E. this term we will be developing our football skills, thinking about the skills we need to develop as well as learning about different tactics and strategies to play the game successfully. We will also be doing dance, looking at putting together a dance through s series of movements and motifs

MfL - Spanish

In Spanish this term we will be learning to say birthday related phrases, as well as learning the language around days, dates, and celebrations.

Home Learning

Reading, reading and more reading. Reading at home is essential to your child's reading development and fluency. It does not have to be the whole book – in year 6 the children are expected to read a minimum of 10 pages every day which will need recording in their reading records.

Additional homework may be given to individuals or whole class depending on areas that need to be revisited or reinforced. The children will have the tasks carefully explained when necessary.
