

## English

Yr 1 will have daily phonics, handwriting and English sessions. We will be busy writing labels and captions before building up to write sentences.

Yr 2 will have daily handwriting, English sessions focusing on skills such as adding commas into a list and adjectives. We will also be completing regular comprehension lessons focusing on an array of stories and poetry.

Our key texts this term are 'Little red riding hood' by Lari Don and 'Pinocchio' by Carlo Collodi.

## Computing

Year 1 will be learning how to group data based on specific information. They will group objects, label and match objects based upon their properties and make comparisons. Year 2 will be focusing on IT around us. They will be recognising technology both around and beyond school, explaining how technology can help us and explore how to stay safe on technology.

## Art

We will be exploring mark making and line, working with different materials through observational and collaborative pieces. DT will follow in Term 2.

## Science

This term we will be learning all about materials.

We will be learning to identify and name a variety of everyday materials including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock.

We will distinguish between objects and the material from which they are made. We will begin to describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.

## Maths

In year 1 this term we will be consolidating our learning of numbers to 10. We will count and sort objects, count and write numbers, count backwards, identify one more and one less, compare numbers and learn to use a number line.

In year 2 we will be focusing on numbers to 100 and addition/subtraction up to and crossing the ten. This will require the children to count in a variety of different ways, partition numbers flexibly and learn automaticity of our number bonds/fact families.



# Y1/2

## Term 1 2025-2026

## History

This term we will be learning about Toys found in the home comparing the similarities and differences to toys from the past and present looking at how they have changed through time.

## Geography

This term we will be learning about weather, months and seasons, identifying the types of suitable clothing to be worn within the different months.

## RE

We will be looking at stories from religious traditions teach about God. We will consider how stories are passed on and help people understand the world.

## Music

We will be introduced to music terminology such as beat, rhythm, melody and echo. We will learn to play a melody on a tuned percussion instrument and sing with good dictation.

## PE

We will be mastering basic movements such as running, jumping, throwing, catching and balance through multi skills and learning to participate in team games through basketball.

## PSHE

We will be ensuring the children make a smooth transition from EYFS to year 1. We will be looking at the importance of washing hands and how to keep ourselves safe whilst on the computers online.
